On May 14, 2024, Grade 7/8 May/Boychuk's homeroom will visit the Human Rights Museum and the Winnipeg Art Gallery. This educational field trip is an integral part of our curriculum, covering topics in Grade 7 Social Studies and Indigenous Learning. The \$10 fee will help cover some of the costs for this trip and all other costs will be covered by MES student council. (Please make cheques payable to MES student council.)

Students will leave MES at 7:45 am sharp, which means students should arrive around 7:40 am ready to depart by school bus.

We will go to the Human Rights Museum for a guided tour starting at 9:30 am.

After the Human Rights Museum, we will go to The Forks for lunch and some leisure time. Students are encouraged to bring either money for lunch or a packed lunch, as we will have the opportunity to explore the area until we head to the Winnipeg Art Gallery for 1:30 pm. The expected return time to MES is 4:15 pm, so please plan for that.
